- 5- Uncle Joe (aka Miss McLeod's Reel, Miss McCloud's Reel; from Scotland) -Heel Toe Polka & Cotton-eyed Joe
- 6- Come Thou Fount of Every Blessing (Irish Air) -Waltz
- 7- Sailor's Hornpipe -Celtic Hornpipe
- 8- St. Anne's Reel - (We'll play this one slow and use it for a Schottische, a Celtic dance)
- 9- La Bastringe -French Canadian (This is technically not Celtic, but was influenced by the Irish and Scottish immigrants that settled in parts of Canada).
